1- OBJECTIVE-SCOPS

This standard specifies the requirements to be followed by certified organizations. Purchasing, verifying and classifying reclaimed forest raw materials (including materials such as bamboo and cork) according to FPC-007 for use in FPC product groups and FPC certification projects. The document also stipulates the definition and implementation of the organization's recycling material input verification program, which aims to ensure its authenticity in terms of quantity, quality and compliance with FPC requirements.

2- GENERAL

2.1 Purchase recycled forest-based materials (including materials Such as bamboo and cork) no FPC declaration should prove the input of its recycling Used for FPC product group or FPC project conforms to FPC definition.

2.2 All recycled materials received should be verified by visual inspection and classified as recycled materials.

2.3 The organization shall retain objective evidence for each supply to confirm recycled materials meet the FPC definition.

2.4 If the received material does not meet the procurement specifications and/or the quantity stated in the invoice is incorrect and the organization should implement it In accordance with the requirements of the FPC standard, immediate follow-up actions are taken to correct the deviation. This Measures should be recorded and communicated to the organization's certification body annual audit.
