## 1- OBJECTIVE-SCOPS

This policy sets out FPC's position on unacceptable activities of organizations that are associated with or wish to associate with FPC and the mechanism for disassociation.

## 2- GENERAL

**2.1** FPC only allows it to be in contact with organizations that are not directly or indirectly involved in the following unacceptable activities:

- Illegal logging or trade in illegal timber or forest products
- Violation of traditional rights and human rights in forestry operations
- Destroy high protection value in forestry operations
- A large number of forests are converted to plantation or non-forest use
- Introducing genetically modified organisms in forestry operations

**2.2** FPC can only form alliances with organizations or individuals with the following characteristics pass due diligence assessment.

**2.3** Any stakeholder, including FPC, can file a formal complaint against the organization Or individuals suspected of participating in any unacceptable activity.

**2.4** Complaints should be filed and handled in accordance with requirements and regulations FPC.

**2.5** The decision to disengage from the FPC can only be made by the FPC board of directors.

**2.6** Action to terminate the contract after deciding to disassociate should establish a relationship with the organization or individual within a period of time twenty-five (25) days.

**2.7** The decision to disassociate may not be appealed.

**2.8** Together with the decision to disassociate, the FPC board of directors can specify the timetable and conditions for the renewal of the association with the FPC.
